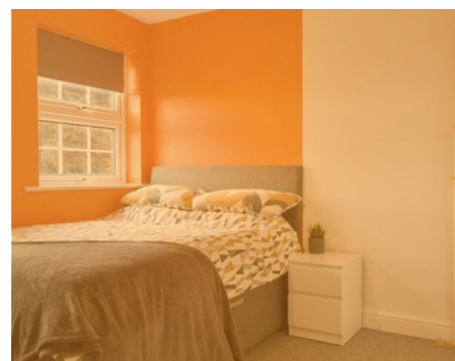

Shared

Room Accommodation is provided within Houses of Multiple Occupation typically up to 8 people in a HMO:

- Inspections are completed 3 times a week
- A Weekly/Bi-Weekly Cleaner for Communal Areas
- Shared Bathroom & Kitchen Facilities
- Fully Furnished (Bed, Wardrobe, Bedside Table & Bedding)
- Minimum stay of 30 nights

Self Contained

Self-contained Accommodation provided through 1, 2, 3 & 4 Bedroom Houses/Flats. Occupied by a single, related household:

- Inspections are completed every 6 weeks
- No shared spaces, fully self-contained
- Fully Furnished (Bed, Wardrobe, Bedside Table & Bedding etc)
- Minimum stay of 7 nights

Why Living Concepts

At Living Concepts we believe that Temporary Accommodation is best provided through settings that resemble home. Having access to regular cooking facilities and individual space ensures our service users don't lose life skills such as cooking and cleaning.

Our light touch and signposting support visits ensure that nobody falls through the net. Tenants are assisted in maintaining and making the necessary appointments throughout their stay with us.
